The Pharmacy Technician program prepares the student with a comprehensive set of skills necessary to become employable as a Pharmacy Technician working in a variety of settings including nursing homes, retail pharmacies, insurance companies, mail-order and web-based pharmacies, pharmaceutical companies, wholesalers, and government agencies. With experience our graduates can move into a hospital setting.

The program contains 2 required courses for employment preparation, job search, and career development. These courses provide soft skills that are necessary for the graduate to obtain the job and pursue the career path of their choice.

Asher College's Pharmacy Technician program allows us to certify a graduate's readiness to work in the field as a licensed Pharmacy Technician in the State of California. After the minimum numbers of hours have been achieved and validation of their skill, the Instructor helps the graduate prepare and file the necessary documents to obtain their state license while finishing up the remainder of their program. The goal is to have their license number at the top of their resume by the time they graduate from Asher College. This assures employers of their credential to work. In addition, they will be prepared to take their national PTCB exam.

Pre-requisites: High school diploma or equivalent documentation. Students should have a 12th grade proficiency in English. Those interested must also have the ability to qualify for their Pharmacy License by passing a Live Scan Background check.
